Audio systems are bounded between the noise floor and the clipping level. The usable room between those boundaries is the dynamic range or signal-to-noise ratio (S/N) of a system. The human ear has a dynamic range of about 120dB from hearing to pain threshold. Studio-grade analog tape recorders achieve 70dB S/N, consumer machines are a lot worse.
