If there is a specific area where a coyote has frequently been sighted, avoid the area if possible until pup-rearing season is over. Remove outdoor food sources such as unsecured garbage, food scraps, compost piles, and pet food. Coyotes and other wildlife will be attracted to these food sources if available. Unattended small pets or livestock ...

There are 19 subspecies of coyotes which are distinguished by their genetic differences and also according to their distribution range of each. 6 subspecies are found in western North America, 2 in the eastern, and 4 in the central North America, while the other 7 are found in Central America and Mexico.

Coyote hunting and trapping seasons are available statewide. Details on season dates and bag limits can be found in the Fur Harvester Digest.. If problems exist outside regular hunting or trapping seasons, coyotes can be killed without a license on private land by the landowner or a designee if the coyote is doing or about to do damage to private property, pets, livestock, or humans.

There were calls to kill coyotes, and trappers contacted the village looking for business. But instead, in 2014 Riverside became the first community in the country to adopt an HSUS plan that uses non-lethal methods to keep communities safe: hazing bold coyotes and teaching residents to protect their pets and remove food sources.

Hunters and trappers are required to report and tag coyote pelts before they are sold, tanned, or mounted. There are special provisions for using land sets to trap coyotes on private land from December 1 through January 31. There are records of coyotes in Indiana as early as 1816, though they likely inhabited Indiana well before that time. There were no documented coyote attacks on humans in Washington state until 2006. In April 2006, Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife officers euthanized two coyotes in Bellevue (King County)after two young children were bitten while their parents were nearby. In January 2014, a statewide hunting and trapping season was established and to date, there have been three coyotes harvested by Delaware hunters: one in northern New Castle County, and two in Sussex County. With an exception for vehicular contact, taking the steps below may decrease coyote encounters in areas where they have been sighted.
